
ETSA President started this competition by giving a brief introduction about the competition and the rules for the competition to the students.

This is one of the acting games which basically uses gestures and mimes to provide clues in a guessing game. It is a way of teaching students to communicate non-verbally in an effective way. It requires use of hands, facial expressions, and the body to mime words.



The game was for a group of players to guess the name of a movie, the name of a song, the name of a novel etc., through a dumb mime. The operative word is 'dumb', so the mimer is banned from using words altogether. Once they have decided what they will be guessing, say 'the name of a movie', they can start the game.
