He became the first Vice President of India (from 1952 to 1962) and the second President of India (from 1962 to 1967). It was his wish that instead of celebrating his birthday on 5th of September every year, it would be better to celebrate it as Teacher's Day all over India. Therefore, it was only natural that his birthday would be celebrated as Teacher's day to pay respect towards teachers across the country. To mark the importance of this day, we celebrate Teacher's day in our college.


